Tracy came in to give an update on the regional zoning board. There was nothing that affected the township discussed at the August and September meetings. There was farm land approved for commercial use with restrictions in Edison and Marengo.

There was survey that went out to the residents of what they would like to see happen in the future to Morrow County. The response was Keep Morrow County Rural but the residents would like to see some restaurants and shopping come in to the county.

The installation of the roundabout at 61/229 has been pushed back to 2025 at this time. At the 61/71 interchange there was talk about an industrial parkway. ODOT gave push back on this issue.

The neighbors next to the clean up property on County Road 156 are still inquiring on when they can have their property line back to put a fence up. The Trustees will take care of this issue.

The Health Department is going to close their complaint on the clean-up on County Road 156. Nicholas Price and Bryan Rutherford came in to discuss the property located on County Road 158. They are continuing to clean up the property. They checked into a storage unit and it would cost them \$30 plus a dollar per foot of the boat. They are going to remove the large boat and a couple more and that will leave 6 boats. 2 in the front and 4 at the back of the property. The Trustees will reach out to the prosecutor for guidance on boats. Dickson moved second by Barkley to adjourn until the next meeting of 12/2/2024.
